New in 2027

We are excited to announce some new initiatives coming in 2027. Here is a quick summary, further information to come.

- **Travel team-** Next year we are looking forward to our first interstate trip! In September 2027, we will be taking our new 'Travel team' (part of our extension programs) to perform at Dreamworld in Queensland. This trip will also include additional dance convention classes, and lots of fun activities.
- **Adult development team-** We have heard you and are excited that our 2027 extension programs will include an Adult Novice team. The perfect place for ex-dancers to return to training.
- **Guardian and Dancer concert performance-** Within our 2027 concerts, we will now be including an option for families to join a special 'Guardian and Dancer' routine on stage. Such a special memory!
- **Student Support fund-** Next year, our Parents committee will be managing a Student support fund to provide financial relief for families. This is intended in alignment with our core value of ensuring dance is always accessible to students.
- **New communication platform-** We know your inbox is busy and sometimes key information is missed. Next year, families will have the option to additionally join our new communication app 'Band' where all key notices will live ongoing and be easily accessible. Less inbox hunting. This space will also allow families to post on the forum to help coordinate things like selling second hand uniform items etc. This also has the capacity to store videos to help students practice at home etc.

Understanding our class options

At CMI, all of our programs fall within two program categories, Core programs & Extension programs. Students are welcome to participate in either program style or both! Take a moment to understand the options below

CORE PROGRAMS

Core programs refer to a full suite of classes across each dance genre we offer, organised by age group. Core programs are a complete dance experience, ideal for students who want quality training and optional performance opportunities without the additional commitment that Extension classes require.

- **Structure:** Weekly classes grouped by genre and age
- **Booking:** Can be booked casually or enrolled as a regular weekly class
- **Payment:** Weekly payment
- **Cancellation:** Minimum 2 hours notice
- **Commitment:** Completely flexible

EXTENSION PROGRAMS

Extension is our team based pathway for dancers who want additional training and performance opportunities beyond what Core programs offer. Places are offered following our Annual Allocation Day, where students try out and are placed into teams.

- **Structure:** Teams are formed across dance genres and grouped by level rather than age, with both development and competitive levels available.
- **Payment:** Weekly payment (plus annual registration fee)
- **Commitment:** Extension is an annual commitment and has higher attendance expectations.

Understanding our class options

Within our Core and Extension programs, we have a range of classes. In 2027, each class will be allocated as either a Performance Class (default) or Skills class. Please take a moment to understand the difference.

PERFORMANCE CLASSES

Performance classes focus on learning and refining choreography and performance skills (with technical training woven into classes too of course). Students in performance classes have the option to perform at our Mid and End of year concerts. Completely optional but open to all students.

SKILLS CLASSES

Skills classes are non-performing classes designed for fast-tracked skill progression. They give students dedicated time to build real technical ability, without that time being shared with choreography or concert prep.

Extension Programs

Alongside our core programs, we offer extension pathways to offer additional training and performance opportunities to dancers. Programs are available in **either Development and Competition based teams**. If your dancer would like to join an extension team in 2027, they are welcome to attend Allocation day. **Please see the seperate attached Extension Program information package to learn more about these programs.**

JAZZ & LYRICAL TEAMS

Our Jazz & Lyrical teams are formed to allow fastracked progression in technique, choreography, and performance skills.

HIP HOP CREWS

We know Hip Hop is a crowd favourite, and our Hip Hop Crews program has been created to ensure students receive dedicated, hip hop specific training.

CHEER SQUAD

Our Cheer Squad program invites selected students to join either the Junior or Senior Cheer squad. Each team will receive specialised training focused on advanced tumbling, stunting, and choreography beyond what's offered in our casual classes.

PRIVATE LESSONS

Our Private Lesson program offers a fully tailored learning experience. Each student is allocated a weekly 30-minute lesson with one teacher.

Lessons are available for solos or duets and can support both recreational and competitive goals. Limited places are available across the week.

TRAVEL TEAM

Next year we are looking forward to our first interstate trip! In September 2027, we will be taking our new 'Travel team' to perform at Dreamworld in Queensland.

Fees

Core Programs- Fees and booking requirements

Extension program fees are outlined in the Extension information package

To continue delivering the quality programs you love, our fees have been adjusted slightly for 2027 to accommodate recent changes to surcharge legislation.

BOOK CASUALLY

- \$14 per class
- Paid when booking
- Book casually when you would like to attend
- Bookings made via iClass
- 2 hour cancellation policy to qualify for a credit or refund
- Cancellations requested via iClass
- To manage our class capacities, casual places are offered as the remaining class places after enrolments. This does mean that the volume of casual spots can fluctuate.
- Where classes are at capacity with enrolments, no casual places would be available for that session.

ENROL YOUR DANCER

- \$12 per class
- Paid weekly via iClass
- Secure an ongoing place in your preferred sessions
- Enrolment made via iClass
- 2 hour absence notification to qualify for a credit or refund (within 80% attendance allowance)
- Weekly fees are payable if you have exhausted your attendance allowance to hold your place.
- 2 week notice required to remove enrolment
- Family discounts available by request

STUDENT SUPPORT FUND

In 2027, we're excited to introduce our Student Support Fund. Run and managed by our Parents Committee, the fund provides financial assistance to help families maintain access to classes and to provide opportunities such as the concert. Further details will be released later this year.

EXTENSION PROGRAMS REGISTRATIONS

- Detailed information regarding all Extension programs is available in the separately attached information package.
- Anyone interested in participating in an extension program in 2027 is welcome to register their dancer via the link below.
- Registrations are open now, until the end of Term. All registered students will then attend 'Allocation day'.
- Team offers will be sent out the following week allowing time for families to review the timetable, their offers and have time to know any additional core classes they would like to register for when core registrations are open at the start of November.
